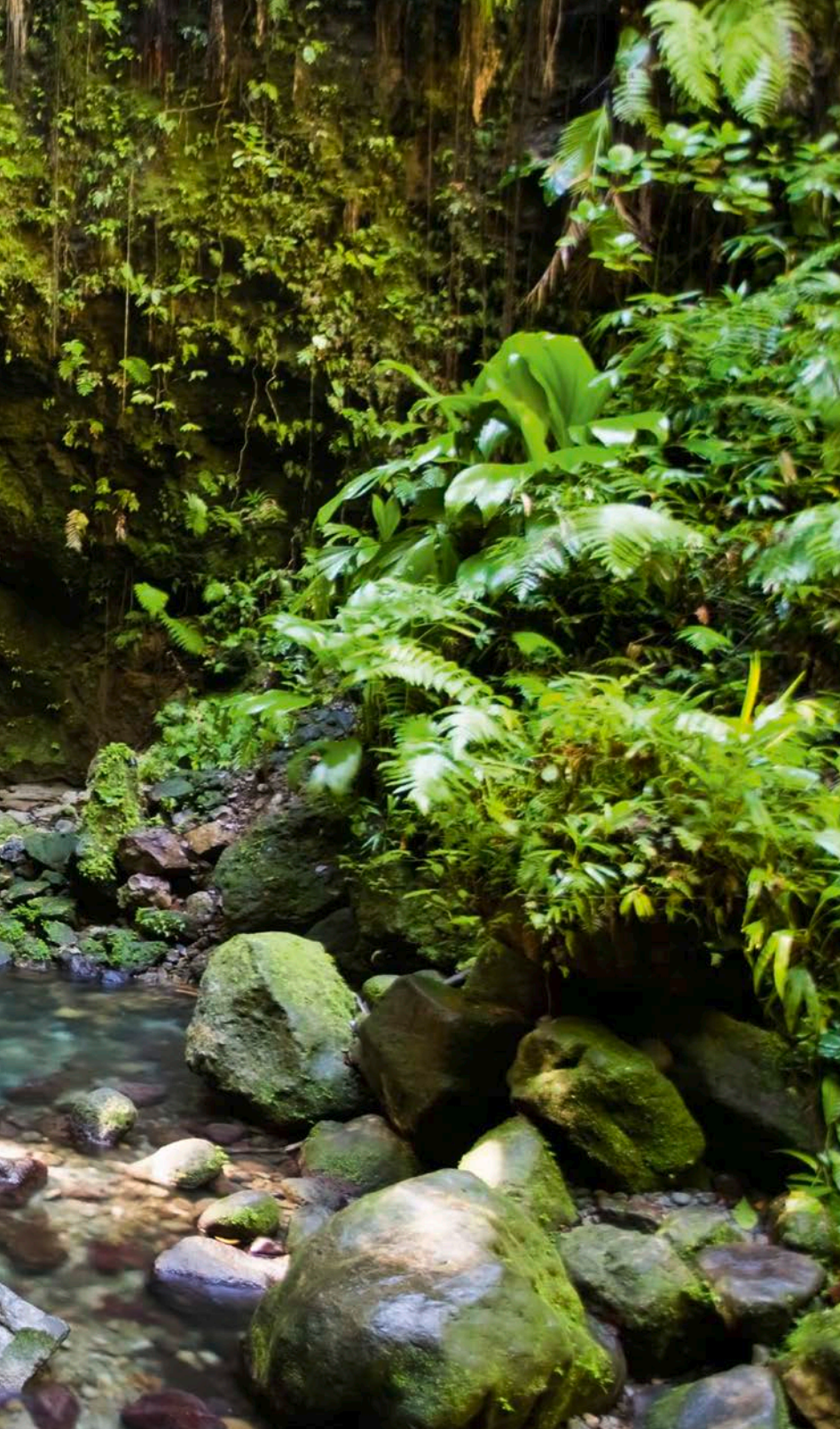




The green side of the Antilles

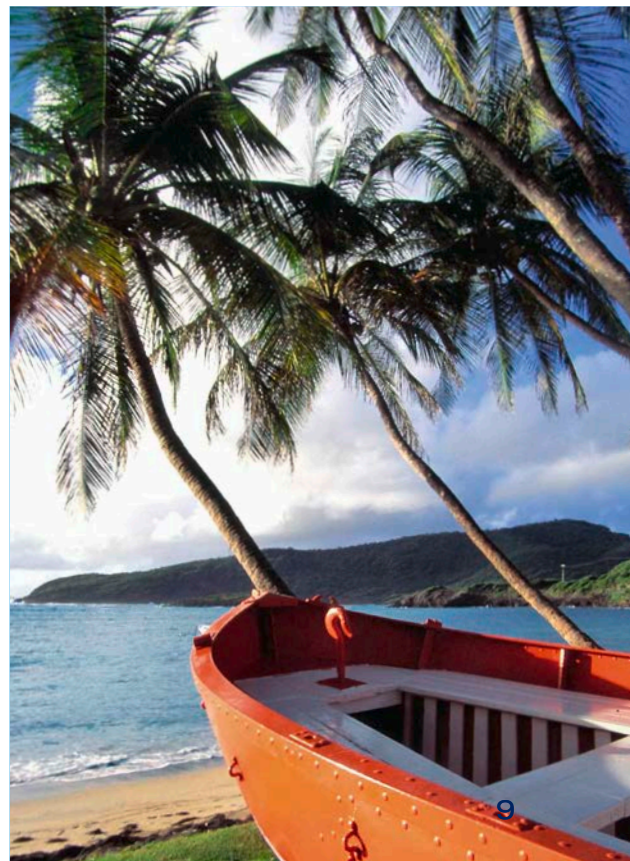

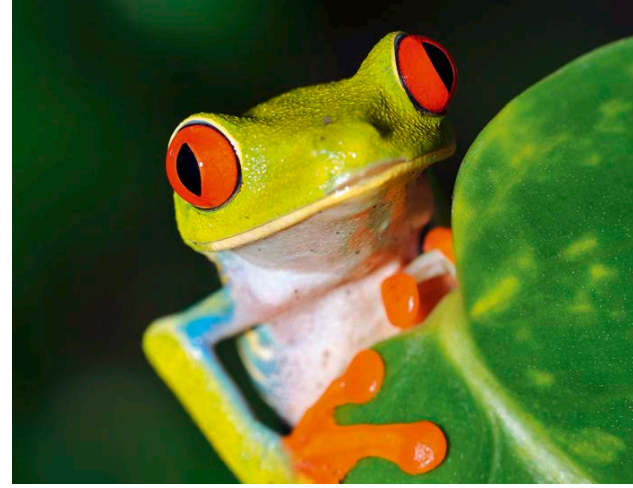




The natural treasures of Costa Rica and Panama

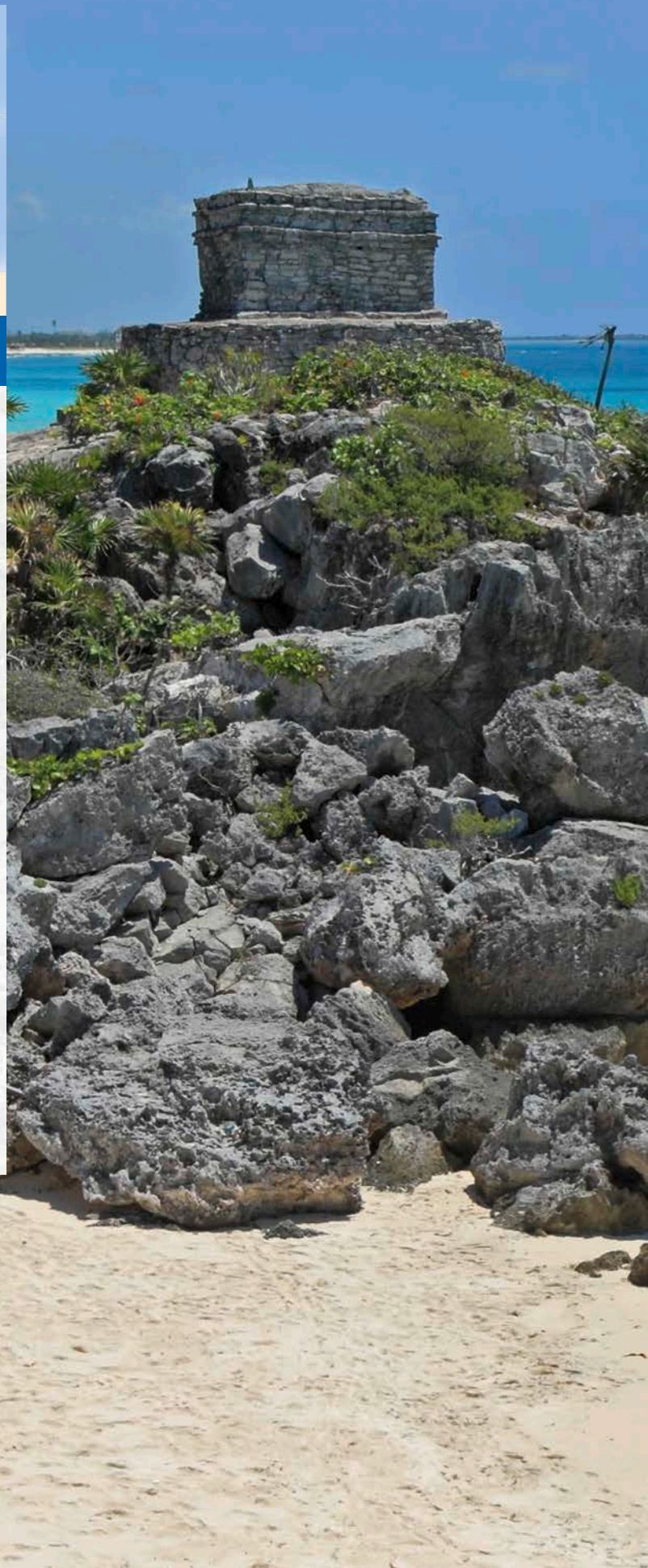

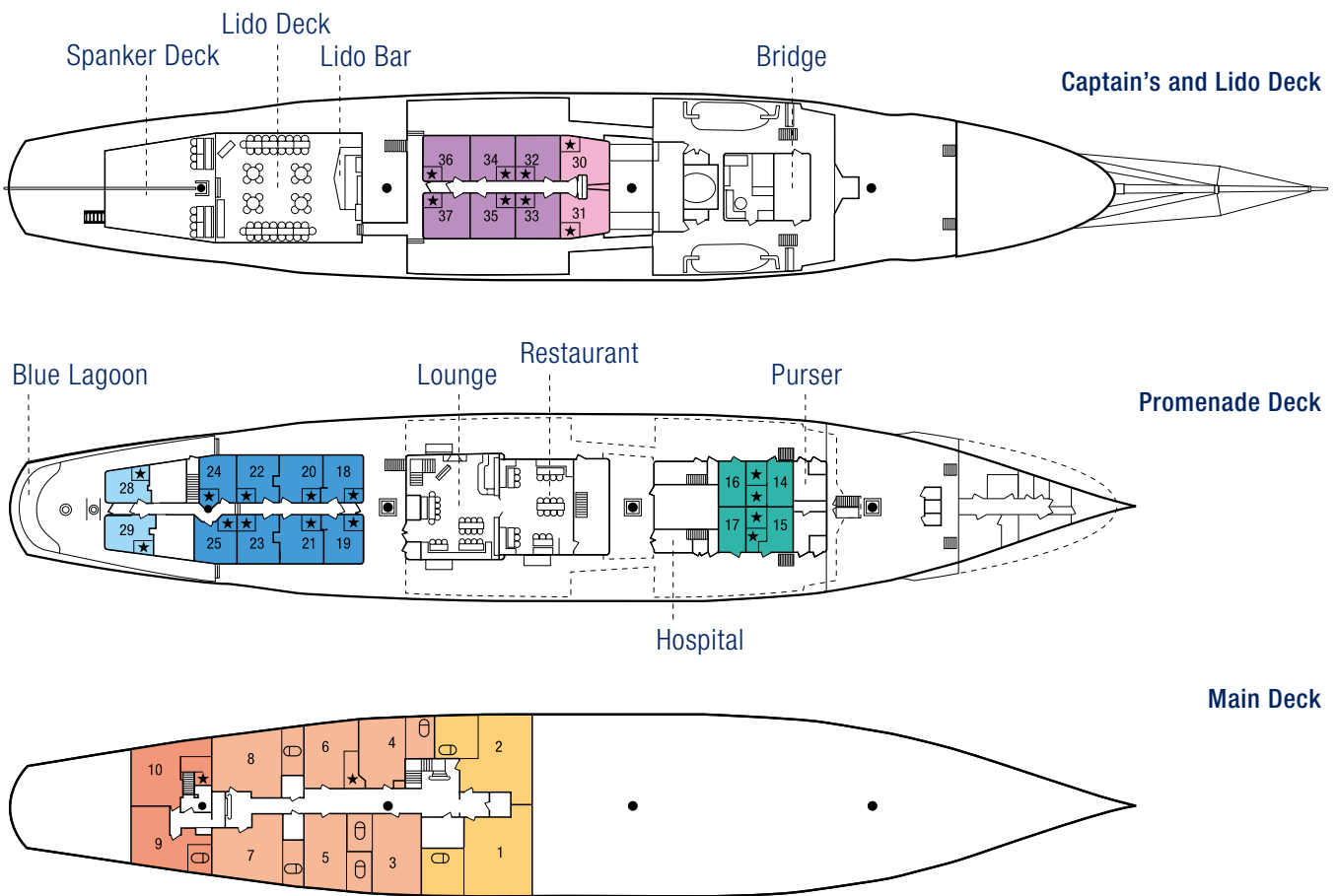

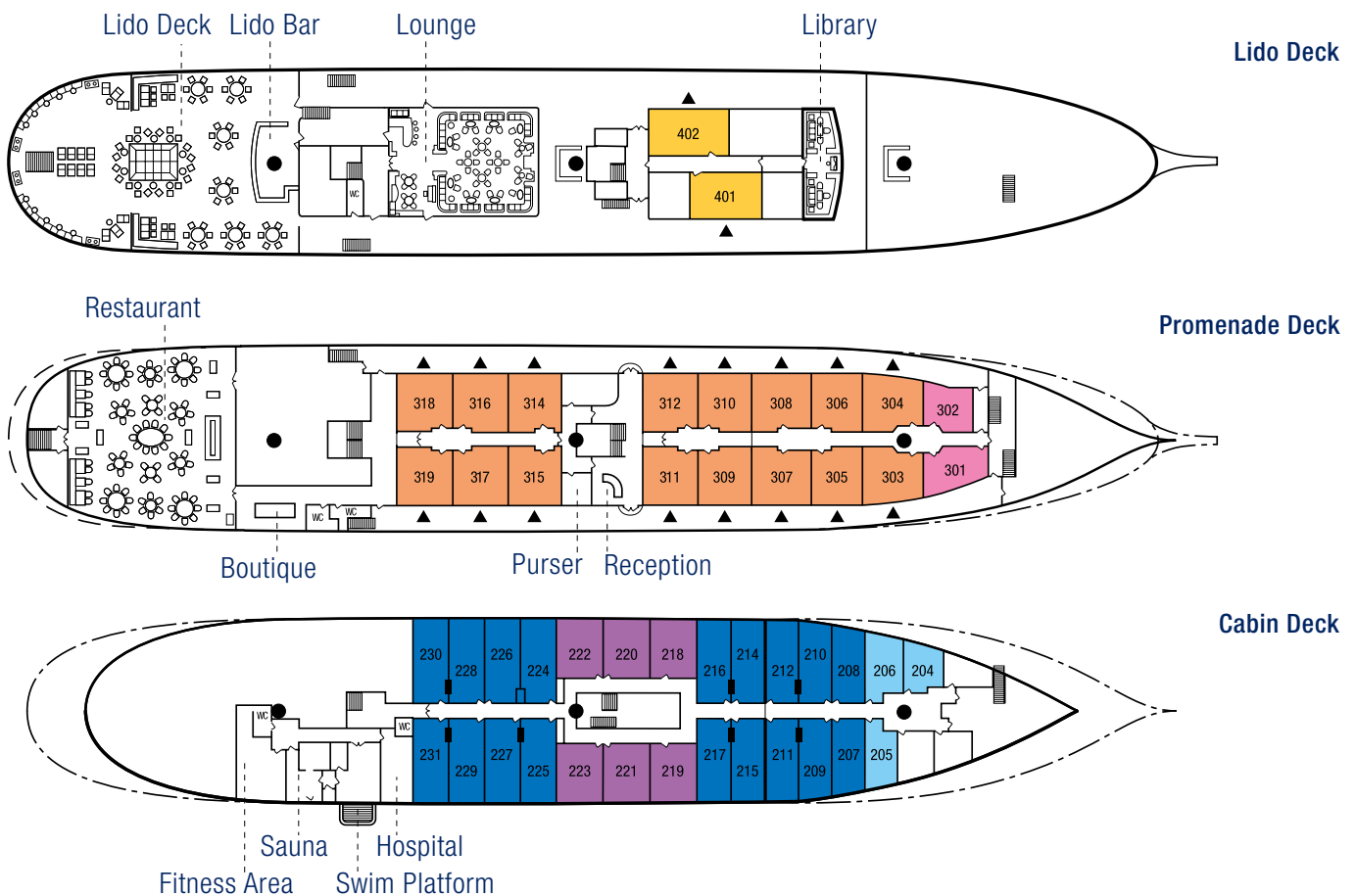
